## Conversations with Jesus (5): Hardness of Heart Matthew 19:1-12

- I. What produces a hard heart?
  - A. Your heart can become hardened when you deny that Jesus is your Sovereign Lord (vv.2;3;9).
  - B. Your heart can become hardened when you study the Bible the wrong way (vv.4; 7-8; James 1:21; Hebrews 4:12; Luke 8:18).
- II. The Truth about Marriage and Divorce
  - A. The Original Creation Law: God's original design for marriage was for one man to be united with one woman for life (Genesis 1:27; 2:24).
  - B. The Temporary Mosaic Law: A certificate of divorce gave legal protection to the wife and limited the abuses of divorce (Deuteronomy 24:1-4).
  - C. Christ's Law for Marriage: Marriage is a permanent union that could only be broken by sexual immorality (v. 9).
- III. How do we prevent hardness of heart?
  - A. Admit your need (v.10).
  - B. Never evade, confuse, or complicate what the Bible says (vv.10-11).
  - C. Realize that God's provision comes to those who want to do His will (v.12).
