- **B.** Trial before the Sanhedrin (4:1-22)
  - 1. 5,000 Jews <u>Believed</u> the Message, but the religious leaders <u>Rejected</u> the Message: Focus goes back to the Name of Jesus Christ (4:7, 10, 12, 17–18)

Politically Incorrect Statement: "12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other Name under heaven given to men by which we must be Saved"

- 2. Peter and John: No Compromise (4:19-20)
- C. The Prayer Meeting (4:23-31): Why Pray?
  - 1. They recognized God's Sovereignty (4:24-28)
  - 2. They asked for Boldness and Power to Witness (4:29-31)

Expect Satan's Opposition, but don't let him Silence your Witness.
