	C. Jehovah-Tsidkenu (Jer 23:6). Our Heavenly Father is a God
	When a Father knows, Obeys and is led by God's Word, his Children will follow his steps and make God of their Fathers their Personal God as well
	D. Jehovah-Rapha (Ex 15:26): Our Heavenly Father His Children when they are Weary and Hurt
	When Fathers have personally Experienced God's Healing and Discipline, they'll learn to apply it in Tenderness to their Children accordingly
	E. Jehovah-Shalom (Jud 6:24): Our Heavenly Father grants to His Children
