## The Magi and the Messiah Matthew 2:1-12

- I. The Magi (v. 1)
  - A. The Bible doesn't tell their number or their names.
  - B. The Magi were high-ranking officials with power and influence (Daniel 1:20, 2:2, 4:7, 5:7).
- II. The Contrasts (vv. 2-10)
  - A. Herod, the wicked usurper king, contrasts with Jesus, the righteous King of Israel by birthright.
  - B. The Gentile Magi's sensitivity and responsiveness to divine guidance contrasts with the insensitivity and unresponsiveness of Israel's religious leaders.

## **III. The Gifts (vv.11-12)**

- A. Gold symbolically pointed to Jesus' role as our King (1 Kings10:14-23; Psalm 45:9, 13; 72:15; Philippians 2:10-11).
- B. Frankincense symbolically pointed to Jesus' role as our Great High Priest (Exodus 30:34, Leviticus 2:1, Nehemiah 13:5).
- C. Myrrh symbolically pointed to Jesus' role as our Redeemer (John 19:38-42, Mark 15:23).
