## From Rubbish to Jesus Philippians 3:1-11

- I. Warning Against False Teachers (vv.1-2)
  - A. False teachers can rob people of joy.
  - B. Commitment to the message of the gospel is the safeguard from all dangers.
- II. Characteristics of Those Who Are Committed to the Gospel (v.3)
  - A. They believe that the Holy Spirit initiates salvation, with the result that love and service for God should follow.
  - B. They believe that Jesus is the One who makes them acceptable to God.
  - c. They understand that confidence in their own achievements and confidence in Christ are mutually exclusive.
- III. Paul's Life before Conversion (vv.4-6)
  - A. A list of Paul's religious credentials (vv.4-5a).
  - B. A list of Paul's personal achievements (vv.5b-6).
- IV. Paul's Conversion (vv.7-9)
  - A. Anything that keeps you from Christ is "rubbish" no matter how good it looks to you.
- V. Paul's Life after Conversion (vv.10-11)
  - A. Paul wanted to experience living, suffering, and dying like Christ in order to know Him better.

## VI. Conclusion

Those who know Christ intimately and authentically will have a life that is characterized by joy.
