Paul's Thank You Note Philippians 4:10-23

I. A Generous Congregation

- A. Generosity is the willingness to use your time, talent, and treasure to benefit others and impact eternity (Philippians 1:5, 4:15-18).
- B. Following Christ as His disciple is a costly and unselfish decision (Philippians 2:27).

II. An Empowered Paul

- A. Contentment is a state of satisfaction that is anchored to our confidence in God resulting in a joyful celebration of life.
- B. Contentment is a learned behavior (v.11).
- C. Contentment is not dependent on our circumstances (v.12).
- D. Contentment is fueled by the strength of God (v.13).

III. A Generous God Worthy of Glory (vv.19-20)

- A. Even when God seems far away, He never stops working in your life.
- B. God will be faithful to meet your needs just at the right time and in His perfect way.
