"Acts – Enlarging God's Kingdom (15-4): Paul's Defense Before Felix" (Acts 24)

It will be an Eternal Regret to let Opportunity pass by without Receiving Christ as Savior

Today: Meet One who Hesitated during the course of Paul's Defense/Witness

- I. 3-fold Accusations from the Sanhedrin (24:1-9)
 - A. The Flattery (Vv 2-4)
 - B. The Accusation (Vv 5-9): 3 Charges

A Personal Charge, a Political Charge, and a Doctrinal Charge

- II. Paul's 4-Point Defense (24:10-21)
 - A. Not Enough time to Instigate a Riot (Vv 11, 17)
 - B. No Evidence that Paul Instigated a Riot (Vv 12-13, 18)
 - C. Paul Worshiped God in Conformity with the Law and the Prophets (Vv 14-16)
 - D. Original Accusers were not Present, and Earlier Trial did not find Paul Committed any Crime (vv 19-21)

Except for one thing: Paul's Belief in the Resurrection of the Dead

III. Response from Felix (24:22-27)

A. Felix Postponed the Case Indefinitely (Vv 22-23): Paul's 2-year Detainment in Caesarea (cf v 27; Phil 1:12-13)

Do not be Limited by Circumstances. Rather, Believing in the Lord who orders every event in our lives, turn whatever Circumstances into something that will Advance God's Kingdom Cause

B. Felix Procrastinated his Decision to Accept the Gospel (Vv 24-27; John 16:8)

Felix's Mind was Informed, his Heart was Convicted, yet he was Unwilling... to Obey the Truth and Repent!

Reflection: Have you heard the Complete Gospel? Take the Step of Repentance!

The most "Convenient Time" to be Saved is — Now (2 Cor 6:2)

And the Best Time to Tell others the Good News of the Gospel is — Now!
