Irreparable Relationships with God, fellowmen, the Environment, and the Reality of Death

- **B.** The Solution to Restlessness
 - 1. A Perfect, Sinless and Willing Substitute Jesus Christ (John 10:11)
 - 2. Grace Invitation: Received only by Grace through Faith

Life, Relationship and Work in Fallen World no longer Burdens of life, but Joy; Believers can go to Jesus for Rest without Guilt

- II. The Assurance from the Invitation to Rest (John 10:27-30)
 - A. The Uncertainty of Eternal Destiny Results in Restlessness
 - B. The Rest Offered by Jesus is both for this Life and for Eternity (John 10:27-30)
 - 1. Jesus Knows who Belong to Him (cf 2 Tim 2:19a)
 - 2. Genuine Christians Exhibits Genuine Characteristics (cf 2 Tim 2:19b)

What if a Believer Sins? Confess and Repent (1 John 1:9)

3. Jesus has both the Power to Save and the Power to Keep
