## I. The Story of Easter

Jesus Christ, who claimed to be the Son of God, Died by Crucifixion and He Rose Again from the Dead on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Day

- A. Jesus' Prophecies of His Crucifixion and Resurrection (John 3:14-15; Matthew 16:21; John 12:31-33)
- B. Jesus' Trials and His Crucifixion: Tomb Guarded and Sealed
- C. Jesus' Burial, Resurrection and Post-Resurrection Appearances (Acts 1:3): The Bible Record and the Non-Christian Secular Sources

## II. What Does the Resurrection of Jesus Christ Mean to You and Me?

A. What Difference Does It Make?

Three Aspects: Our Past, Our Present and Our Future

- B. The Scriptural Answer (Romans 1:1-5)
  - Prior to "Becoming" a Descendant of David, Jesus is the "Son of God" He is <u>Deity</u>
  - Jesus Christ is the Fulfillment of the Gospel Promised in the Old Testament
  - Jesus is the Gospel the Good News

The Gospel Message: Christ Died for our Sins, was Buried and Rose Again on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Day (cp. 1 Corinthians 15:1-4)

C. Connecting the Solution to the Cause of Men's Problems (1 Corinthians 15:21-22)

Mankind Inherited the Nature of Sin, and the Consequence of Sin – Death; All are Born Separated from the Holy God – the Source of Life

• Performance Remedy vs. Grace-based Remedy
