I. Why are there Controversies?

- 1. The Sin Nature in Us: Pride and Jealousy
- 2. Different, but Legitimate Views on Ministry: Paul and Barnabas (Acts 15:36-41)
- 3. Traditions, Upbringing, Social Pressure, Personality and Personal Experience
- 4. Maturity Level of Believers' Faith (Romans 14:1)

Most Issues in Life Fall in the Gray Zone, and Grace Operates in the Gray Zone to Create Harmony and Unity

II. How to Deal with Controversies (Romans 14:1-15:2)

- 1. Accept Those who Hold Different Views from You
 - a. Be Considerate for the "Weak in Faith" (14:1-3)
 - b. Accept those whom God has Accepted (14:5-8)
 - c. Do Not Criticize God's Servants (14:4, 10)
- 2. To the "Weak": Transform Your Paradigm be Teachable (14:14, 22-23)

Personal Conviction or Personal Preference?

Insisting that others conforming to "My Way" is not Grace, but Legalism!

3. To the "Strong": Give Up Your Own Preferences (14:13; 15:1-2)

God's Kingdom is not about Me and My Agenda, but the Welfare of the Church, and God's Purpose

- Accept One Another, be Teachable; and continue to be Transformed by Grace
- Be Considerate of the Weaker and Younger Fellow Believers in Faith
